



Redemption Christian Ministries places our focus on bringing in people and helping them to grow, learn and in turn, reach new people. Using the Ambassador's For Christ (AFC) model, we have empowered everyday people with the tools that they need to successfully share the gospel.

The Ambassador's for Christ (AFC) presentation is a simple one. The first component is the two diagnostic questions:

1. Have you come to a point in your life where you know for CERTAIN that if you were to die today you would go to HEAVEN?
2. Suppose you were to die right now and stood before God and he were to ask you, "Why should I let you into my HEAVEN?" What would you say?

With these basic questions we are able to transition into five fundamental points:

1. **Heaven** – Everyone talks about heaven right? (Their answer) Everyone wants to go to heaven right? (Their answer) You're right, but there is a problem with us getting into heaven, let me show you what that is. (Refer to Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God)
2. **Man** – The problem is man is a sinner and because he is a sinner he cannot save himself. Also, because he is a sinner, there is a penalty that must be paid for the sin. Let me show you what that is. (Refer to Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord).
3. **God** – Our God is a just God and he must punish the sin but at the same time, God is a merciful God and a loving God and he doesn't want to punish us. Because he loves us so much, he did something for us to help us. Let me show you what that is. (Refer to John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish but have everlasting life.)
4. **Jesus** – God loves us so much that he allowed his Son to suffer the penalty for our sins. Do you have children? Would you allow your child to suffer for something that someone else did? (their answer) I wouldn't either. But God loves us that much, he finds us that valuable that he allowed his son to pay the price for our sins. (Drive this point; help them to see God's love).
5. **Faith/Gift** – Jesus paid the price and now makes heaven available for us as a gift. When someone has a gift for you what do you have to do to get it? (Their answer) That's right you don't have to do anything, you just take it. Let me show you how to get this gift. Let's take a look at Ephesians 2:8-9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God. Not of works, lest any man should boast. You cannot do anything to get this gift. You get this gift by receiving it by faith.

Explain faith using the chair analogy –eg. You did not examine the chair to make sure that it would hold you before you sat down did you? Faith in Jesus is just like the faith in the chair. You have to have absolute trust and dependence in Jesus and what he has done to give you this gift.

“Does this make sense to you?” (their answer) This gift is available to you if you want it. “Would you like to have this gift?” (their answer) When they say that they want to receive the gift then:

1. Reiterate all that you have covered for clarity.
2. Explain the prayer (Refer to Romans 10:9-10 If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised him from the dead, then you will be saved. For with the heart man believes unto righteousness and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Be sure to take their information, invite them to church and follow up with them. The same way one doesn't have a baby and leave them in the hospital, one does not make a disciple and expect them to survive all on their own.
